MÉTHODE CAP CLASSIQUE

In 1971 the first “Sparkling Wine” in South Africa was released by the Simonsig Estate. This heralded an exciting new phase in South African wine making circles. In 1992 a group of like-minded South African winemakers who had a passion for bottle fermented Sparkling wine, made according to the traditional Champenoise Méthode, joined forces to form the Cap Classique Producer’s Association. The Association’s vision in two fold was to promote South Africa’s premium Méthode Cap Classique wines (MCC) and to ensure that MCC becomes the generic term for these wines, which will enable them to take their rightful place on the world stage.

NV	FAIRVIEW CHARLES BACK Paarl Pale, yellow colour with a tinge of green. Aromas of lime, apple and freshly baked Ciabatta crust on the nose, followed by a creamy palate with green apples, quince and a lingering freshness.	465

CHAMPAGNE

There are many sparkling wine produced worldwide, yet most legal structures reserved the word champagne exclusively for sparkling wines from the Champagne region. The primary grapes used in the production of Champagne are Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and Pinot Meunier. Champagne appellation law only allows grapes grown according to appellation rules in specifically designated plots within the appellation to be used in the production of Champagne.

NV	VEUVE CLIQUOT PONSARDIN Reims An intense pleasant fragrance, with fruit and brioche notes. It is well balanced and pleasantly fresh to taste, with remarkable fruity structure. It's the perfect aperitif and a welcome accompaniment with seafood.	2100
NV	MOËT & CHANDON BRUT IMPERIAL Epernay A harmonious blend of all three varietal and reserve wines, with the aim to produce a consistent, subtle, drier-style Champagne, delicately vinous with a lime and vine blossom attack.	2200

ITALIAN PROSECCO

Prosecco is produced in Veneto region in Northern Italy. It Dons from a small village and is fermented solely from the grape variety called Glera.

NV	MILLESIMATO PROSECCO Italy This prosecco is pale yellow in colour, with a fine and persistent mousse this is a soft Prosecco, with an excellent balance of fruit and acidity.	410
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SAUVIGNON BLANC

The Cape produces superb examples of Sauvignon Blanc. A food friendly varietal which pairs well with veggie dishes, salads, Goats cheese, tomatoes, asparagus, lemon and vinaigrettes.

2018	ESONA Robertson This Sauvignon Blanc is crisp. Made in a serious style. Delicate hints of green peppers, fresh cut herbs and sea spray aromas integrate superbly with vibrant nuances of minerality in the finish.	320
2020	CONSTANTIA ROYALE Constantia Herbaceous freshness, tightly couled, focused varietal. Varietal intensity and acidity, showcases cooler maritime provenance.	310
2020	NITIDA Durbanville Immediate elegance, full of lemon grass and fresh apples. Followed by mellow green fig and white peach around a heart of pure minerality. Fantastic partner to a Line fish or salad.	280
2019	EAGLES' NEST Constantia West Coast and Durbanville grown grapes, vinified at Eagles' Nest in Constantia, typical coastal Sauvignon with plenty of fresh fruit, uncomplicated and refreshing.	320
2020	WATERFORD Stellenbosch A more steely style Sauvignon blanc showing restraint granadilla, white pear and soft floral notes, underlying chalk and slate notes confirming the Elgin origin of the grapes.	340
2019	KLEIN CONSTANTIA ESTATE Constantia Ripe but delicate aromas of yellow stone-fruit, good mineral core, nicely balanced with a fresh finish.	400

GEWÜRZTRAMINER

This wine has full-bodied texture and intensely spicy flavours. The first vines planted in South Africa originate from Alsace. Gewürztraminer pairs well with Thai curries as it stands up to the assertiveness of the style of curry.

2018	BUITENVERWAGTING Constantia Fermented and matured in French Oak for 10 months, this Gewurz has Beautiful subtle characteristics on the nose and pallet, round soft mid palate and at the same time very elegant. This "Old-World" style of Gewurz.	650
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CHARDONNAY

This noble grape variety made famous in Burgundy is found in most wine-producing countries today. Full-bodied Chardonnays go especially well with creamy dishes, poultry and most types of fish. Medium bodied Chardonnays can be enjoyed with Smoked Salmon, terrines and cheese.

2020	WARWICK “THE FIRST LADY” UNWOODED Western Cape A pale straw colour with a hint of green in the glass. Intense nose of fresh pineapple, lemon, citrus and floral notes. The mid-palate is broad and appealing, supported by a lingering acidity.	250
2019	DE WETSHOF “FINESSE” Robertson This wine has strong citrus flavours with a pronounced nuttiness on the mid-palate which leads through to a clean finish with zesty citrus notes. Mature in french oak barrels and remains on lees for a few months.	400
2019	UVA MIRA “THE MIRA” Helderberg Gently oaked and refreshing in style with enticing minerality, a lovely floral fragrance and subtle spice. A wine of intense purity with sweet, juicy lime offset by a lingering acidity.	580
2018	GROOT CONSTANTIA Constantia A full-bodied wine with citrus and subtle spice on the nose.	710
2019	GLEN CARLOU Paarl Medium straw colour, with tinges of green on the rim, rich in citrus, green apples and oak nuance. 100% barrel fermented in French oak; furnish the wine with a toasted and creamy oak character, it is complemented by ripe pear.	820
2018	HAMILTON RUSSELL - ORGANIC Hemel – En – Aarde Valley One of South Africa’s flagships offering a stylistic resemblance to the wines of Puligny and Meursault. Very complex it combines the sense of the Old and New world. Showing a melange of lime, apple, melon and white truffle, also some savoury notes.	1300

RIESLING

Of all the classic white varieties, it is perhaps the most notable for its longevity, developing extraordinary complexity in the bottle over many years and maintaining that peak performance for many more. Enjoy with lightly spiced dishes and fruity desserts.

2015	LOTHIAN VINEYARDS Elgin Very pale colour with green hues. The aroma has a hint of the classic Lothian Riesling characters but is most redolent of green mango, nectarines and lychees. The palate shows great length and finesse with a vibrancy of perfumed fruits such as guava and sweet peach, overlaid with a touch of white cherry, sorbet and clove.	320
2018	PAUL CLUVER ‘DRY ENCOUNTER’ Elgin Wonderfully fragrant, concentrated fruit and floral notes. Lots of mango, orange and frangipani with a sweet melon finish. Lovely lime and lemongrass finish.	300

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CHENIN BLANC

This very versatile variety produces good natural wines covering the whole spectrum from sweet to dry, Sherry as well as Sparkling wine. Chenin Blanc is currently by far the most planted grape variety. Ideal pairings are seafood, Sushi, salads and sweeter styles Chenin Blanc's can balance the heat of spicy dishes.

- 2019 MULDERBOSCH 210**
Stellenbosch
Pale straw colour with a splash of green. Intense nose with Bartlett pear, red apple, tarragon, persimmon and lime peel. The mid-palate is broad and appealing with a surprising creamy texture adjunct with subtle jasmine and frangipane notes.
- 2020 MULLINEUX KLOOF 250**
Swartland
Pale straw in colour, this wine has a nose of sun ripened pears and wet granite. The palate has a vibrant acidity balanced by a soft, round texture and some pithy character. The wine has a fresh, mineral finish.
- 2020 CEDERBERG 285**
Cederberg
showing a powerful nose of tropical melon, grapefruit and lemon peel. Five months of lees contact created a mouth tingling crispness with a lingering finish. Superb food compatibility.
- 2020 JORDAN "INSPECTOR PERINGUEY" 360**
Stellenbosch
A contemporary and deliciously mouth-filling experience of citrus cream, tropical fruit and honey interlaced with a spicy complexity.
- 2019 REMHOOGTE "HONEYBUNCH" 620**
Stellenbosch
Pale golden yellow colour. The nose is complex. The palate is rich and full bodied with a creamy texture, livened by a fresh acidity.

SEMILLON

This grape was once considered to be the most planted grape in the world. Although this is no longer the case. In the 1950's Chile's vineyards were made up of over 75 percent Semillon. Today it accounts for just 1 percent of South African vineyards.

- 2019 CONSTANTIA UITSIG 530**
Constantia
One of Constantia's most celebrated Semillons. This wooded Semillon is rich and full-bodied, with hints of orange peel, candied tangerine, hazelnuts and marzipan. Matured for 7 months in light toast barrique. Quality of vintage is well reflected in this wine.
- 2018 STEENBERG VINEYARDS 570**
Constantia
A speciality of the house, notes of tangerine and fresh cut green grass, litchi and fragrant lime zest, full bodied with a waxy-flinty finish. Fermented in French Barrique for 6 weeks showing hints of sweet spices. Only made in exceptional vintages.

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VIOGNIER

An early ripener and very hard to grow even in perfect conditions. It has an exuberant character which is head-spinningly perfumed and opulent, but dry. In spite of lowish acidity, it is full-bodied with seductive flavours of apricot, peach, musk and lime blossom.

- 2020** **CREATION** **350**
Hemel – En - Aarde Ridge
Delightfully forthcoming on the nose with pertinent peach and subtle hints of ripe pear. The aromas fine resonance on the smooth palate where apricots blends seamlessly with crisp minerality and well integrated natural acidity.
- 2018** **EAGLES' NEST** **545**
Constantia
Constantia's first bottling from this Rhône Valley grape. Dried yellow fruits such as apricots and peaches, fresh lime and hints of sweet oak spices add to the complex mouth-feel. Matured in French oak for 6 months.

WHITE BLENDS

Recent years have seen the South African winemakers explore many different combinations of blended white wines. Blends that range from Chardonnay, Chenin Blanc, Viognier, Semillon, Etc. As a result the wines are interesting and challenging. Often you will discover something completely new. These wines accompany cold meats, salads, spice, seafood along with pasta very well depending on the style of wine.

- 2020** **BUITENVERWACHTING 'BUITEN BLANC'** **180**
Constantia
Full bodied Sauvignon Blanc based blend offers a variation of fruit characters. Including gooseberry, green peppers, green melon and hints of tropical fruit.
- 2017** **WATERKLOOF "CIRCLE OF LIFE"** **410**
Stellenbosch
Sauvignon Blanc aromas are prominent on the nose with lime and prickly pear showing off. Intense flavours, with great balance. A tight mineral core and creamy mid palate from the Chenin Blanc allows for great complexity and a persistent finish. The Sauvignon Blanc lends a lovely fresh acidity to the wine
- 2018** **DE GRENDEL "WINIFRED"** **460**
Platterkloof
Complex nose of peach, preserved lemon, honeycomb and jasmine. A zesty youthfulness, freshness and vibrancy with a good dash of minerality to end with an intense.
- 2018** **WADE BALES "CONSTANTIA"** **650**
Constantia
Fresh aromas of passion fruit, nettle and lime following through on the palate with luscious citrus and winter melon from the Sauvignon Blanc component. An undertone of sweet spice derived from the Semillon barrel-fermented in French oak to add complexity to the wine
- 2018** **CONSTANTIA GLEN "TWO"** **720**
Constantia
Elegant white blend with subtle aroma of apricot, and pineapple. Lovely undertone of lime and gentle oak fruit integration.
- 2015** **STEENBERG "MAGNA CARTA"** **1450**
Constantia
The nose shows aromas of elderflower, gooseberries and orange blossom.
The palate is broad and textured with a bright line of acidity giving the wine backbone.

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BLANC DE NOIR

The differences in taste and appearance between a Blanc de Noir and a Rosé wine can be attributed to different wine-making methods. The red grapes are crushed and the juice is slowly drained off. As the juice moves through the skins, colour leaches out and this is the colour of the final wine. This wine is a perfect complement to any meal, especially Duck, Calamari and cold meats.

2020 BUITENVERWACHTING 180
Constantia
Appealing red fruit character, light to medium body supported by a fine freshness.

ROSÉ

The delicate pink colour of these wines is achieved by allowing the juice, once pressed, very limited contact with the skins to extract a little of the colour. The result is light wine with some of the characteristics of a red but without the accompanying heaviness. Perfect for hot summer days and as a Sundowner.

2020 QUANDO 220
Robertson
The wine is pale rose petal pink in colour. Red Berries, rhubarb and cassis on the nose follow through with a juicy fruitiness on the palate and velvety aftertaste.

2020 HERMANUSPIETERSFONTEIN 'BLOOS' 250
Walker Bay
Delivers fresh red fruits with creamy undertones of dark berries and pleasant floral notes

2020 WATERKLOOF 'CAPE CORAL' MOURVÉDRE - ORGANIC 320
Stellenbosch
Pale, salmon colour. Delicate floral aromas, with hints of minerality are prominent on the nose. The palate is soft, fresh and supple, finishing with a balanced acidity. Traditionally the wine is served on its own, but also marries well with salmon and fresh dishes.

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PINOT NOIR

The oldest of the wine grape varieties originated in Burgundy, where it is recorded to have existed since the fourth century. Depending on the climate and ripeness, it's varietal flavour can range from cherries to strawberries. This wine is to be enjoyed with a wide variety of dishes such as Duck, Grilled Salmon, Brie and Camembert cheese.

PINOTAGE

Developed by Prof. Abraham Perold in 1925, Pinotage is the result of a cross between Pinot Noir and Cinsaut (then known as Hermitage). The wine boasts the truly distinctive sweetness of red berry fruit with a characteristic banana like aroma and flavour. To be enjoyed with Game dishes, deboned Roast stuffed with fruit, as well as dishes based on mushrooms and Liver.

Made in an elegant and traditional style the wine shows vibrant fruity notes of fresh cherry, raspberry and hints of vanilla given by the oak. The palate exhibits savoury tannins with ample fruit with a lingering finish. | 410 |

Simonsberg-Paarl
An exclusive allocation from an acclaimed Cape vintage. Produced from low-yielding estate bush vines, the result is a parade of dark fruit, spice, a little marshmallow and cherry tobacco aromas. The palate shows real length - red fruits and tannic grip. | 530 |
| 2018 | GROOT CONSTANTIA
Constantia
A dark hued, full-bodied wine. Aromas of dark chocolate, cherries and ripe plums on the nose followed by ripe strawberry and juicy plum on the palate. These juicy flavours are well-balanced by firm tannins adding complexity to the wine. | 720 |

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MERLOT

Merlot produces beautifully coloured wines, soft in fruit but capable of great richness. Recommended to partner lamb, duck, cheeses with high acidity such as chevin and feta.

2020	HERMANUSPIETERSFONTEIN 'POSMEESTER' Walker Bay Purple fruit such as blueberries, currants (black and red) with a milk chocolate undertone. Lush and juicy on the palate.	260
2018	DE GRENDEL Plattekloof Bright ruby colour with a light red rim. The nose offers upfront aromas of raspberry, graphite and fresh plums. The wine presents fleshy plums and currants on the palate, underpinned by earthy flavors such as tobacco and liquorice.	435
2016	ANURA RESERVE Paarl This full-bodied, well balanced wine has loads of ripe blackberry, red berry and blackcurrant flavours with hints of herbal and violet aromas.	465
2016	EAGLES' NEST Constantia Minty and fragrant cool climate Merlot, plenty of dark fruit with a firm structure. Nicely balanced, 18 months French oak maturation is well absorbed, medium bodied with a clean finish.	545
2016	MEERLUST Stellenbosch Deep, youthful purple colour with a ruby rim. Hints of dark chocolate and inkiness. The palate offers generous, ripe, pure Merlot fruit with refreshing acidity.	795

SHIRAZ / SYRAH

It is claimed that Syrah or Shiraz as it is called in South Africa and Australia, originated in The Persian town of Shiraz. It can produce some of the world's finest deepest and darkest reds with intense flavours and excellent longevity. Accompany with red meat dishes, stuffed Quail, jellies and Cottage Pie, as well as mushrooms on toast. It does not like fiery hot dishes and acidic food.

2018	DELAIRE GRAFF Stellenbosch A ripe and approachable Shiraz with a ruby colour and purple tints with a spicy white pepper undertone as well as lavender and dark red fruit aromas of mulberries.	320
2016	ARRA Stellenbosch It has fresh spicy flavors on the pallet with a light texture still providing a lovely finish from the Shiraz variatel. The wine is Oaked in French barrels for 12 months which provides a great balance to the flavor and aging process.	350
2018	AREND SIG Robertson Scent of tabacco, cigar box, spice, cherries and fresh red fruit on the nose. This is a fruit driven wine with round tannins.	460

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2015	EAGLES' NEST Constantia Dense aromas of cherry on the nose and light red fruit with hints of light creamy	780
2016	GROOT CONSTANTIA Constantia Blackcurrant, raspberry and plum flavours are married with clove, white pepper and black pepper spices. Smooth tannins give it a lengthy finish.	695

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

It is the noblest red grape in the world. Robust and sometimes austere on its own. The addition of Merlot and Cabernet Franc softens it and adds complexity. Cabernet is synonymous with France's finest wines. The wine needs a fairly long period of wood maturation and bottle-ageing to reach its potential. Perfect to combine with beef, lamb and venison, rosemary and thyme. Also paired with steak and kidney pie.

2018	WARWICK "THE FIRST LADY" Western Cape Deep and intense ruby red colour. The bouquet reveals red berries, black currants and pleasant herbal characters with smooth, ripe and round tannins.	290
2017	CEDERBERG Cederberg Loads of blackcurrants with cedar wood undertones on the nose with a hint of smokiness and tobacco leaf, creating a complex wine.	560
2016	JORDAN "LONG FUSE" Stellenbosch Fully developed flavours and soft ripe tannins with elegance captured from the various cabernet slopes. Classic essences of cedar, brambles and toasted tobacco.	540
2017	GROOT CONSTANTIA Constantia Blackcurrant, cherries, plums, a hint of cigar box and mint on the nose. A complex wine that is full on the palate, packed with fruit flavour and the tannins to support for good ageing.	675
2017	STARK-CONDE Stellenbosch Blackberry fruit aromas with tea-leaf and cedar notes. The palate is rich and polished with dark fruit and mocha flavours and a finely balanced acidity.	560
2016	UVA MIRA "THE MIRA" Helderberg, Stellenbosch A wine of poise possessed with real elegance and polished tannins. The nose is fresh, clean and refined showing aromas of deep blackberry, graphite and freshly picked violets.	610
2017	RUST - EN - VREDE Stellenbosch Complex structure of smoke aged meat, blackcurrant, chocolate and hints of cigar and lead pencil shavings. Medium to full bodied in structure.	850

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CABERNET FRANC

Cabernet Franc is one of the genetic parents of Cabernet Sauvignon – The other being Sauvignon Blanc. Depending on the vineyards practices, the flavour profile of the Cabernet Franc may be both fruitier and sometimes more herbal than Cabernet Sauvignon, although lighter in colour and softer in tannin.

- 2016 HERMANUSPIETERSFONTEIN ‘SWARTSKAAP’ 725**
Walker Bay
As the name suggests, “black sheep” makes for a remarkable wine, independent and confident, denouncing Cabernet franc’s status as “a blending cultivar”. Violet to ruby red appearance with aromas of black olives and blackcurrant and a generous palate
- 2017 RAATS FAMILY WINES 1250**
Stellenbosch
Rich, compact and deep with aromas of coffee and strawberries, beautifully balanced fruit and oak components. 16 months French oak maturation, only 20% in 1st fill.

RED BLENDS

The exact definition of a cape style red blend has yet to be decided. That said the wines below offer some of the finer South African blends. The Bordeaux style wines obviously contain either all or some of the classic Bordeaux grapes.

- 2018 BUITENVERWACHTING “MEIFORT” 310**
Constantia
Full bodied and complex red blend. Warm and inviting nose showing elegant plum, red cherry characters combined with spicy oak and tobacco characters.
- 2019 EIKENDAL “CHARISMA” 360**
Stellenbosch
Unique blend of Shiraz, Petit Verdot and Sangiovese. Has fresh structure with rich berry and fruity characters. The result is a bold, charming, seductive and ultimately elegant wine.
- 2016 BOSCHENDAL “NICOLAS” 585**
Franschhoek
A blend brimming with character.
